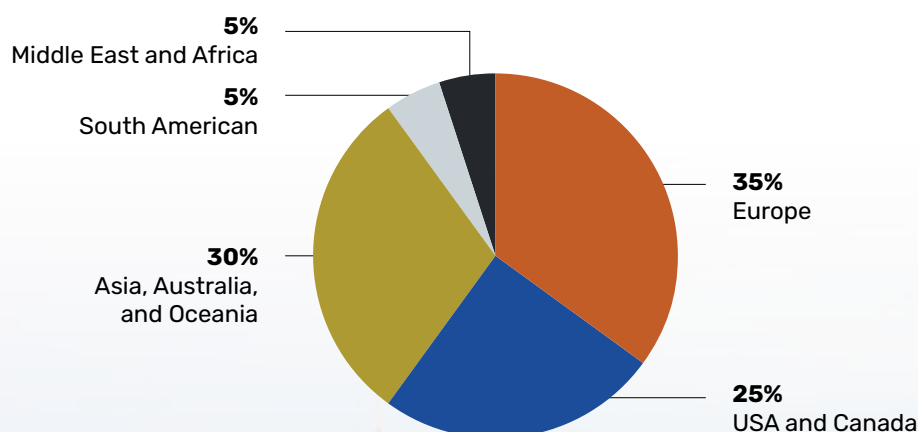
About the IASP 2026 World Congress on Pain

Cancellation, Postponement or Relocation of Conference.
