Weighting 15%

Cooperation with others

Written response must address (Maximum 300 words):

AV presentations taken or produced by IPWEA-QNT are not available to entrants. 8. Please do not upload any further written material as the judges will not consider these. The written component of your entry should be fully explained within the provided form fields. Upload your preferred primary image, "hero shot", which best reflects your project, employer or person. Please note this photo will be used in other IPWEA-QNT publications and marketing materials. Please do not upload a logo or blank document. Refer to "Photography Requirements" for more information.
