





The AAPM Sexual and Gender Minority Subcommittee (SGMSC) Trainee Travel

Award was created to assist medical physics students and trainees in the LGBTQIA2S+ community, an under-represented population in the field, and LGBTQIA2S+ allies with a demonstrated history of championing and/or supporting LGBTQIA2S+ equity. The award covers expenses related to AAPM Annual Meeting attendance (travel, lodging, registration, etc.) up to \$2,000.

Award Criteria

Applicants must submit a personal statement along with their CV describing research-, education-, or service-based motivation to

attend the proposed meeting along with a letter of support from their program mentor or supervisor. This merit-based grant can be awarded to all members of the AAPM who have a demonstrated history of championing and/or supporting LGBTQIA2S+ equity.
